We write to advise the Commission of Errata to the Counsel's Argument which was filed on behalf of BC Hydro in the subject proceeding, on April 19, 2006. Details of the Errata are as follows:

- Paragraph 20, second sentence, add "s" to the word "type" rendering the sentence to read as follows, "BC Hydro understands the need to make subjective judgments in these types of circumstances and accepts that relatively minor cost increases may be justified where significant public acceptance issues are in play."
- Paragraph 20, third sentence, add "the", rendering the sentence to read as follows, "In general, BC Hydro accepts that the additional cost of Option 2 may be justified in this case if it results in a significant increase in the level of public acceptance in Tsawwassen."
- Paragraph 76, first sentence, add "not", "even", and "built" rendering the sentence to read as follows, "For all these reasons, BC Hydro agrees with BCTC's conclusions that the Juan de Fuca project is not virtually certain to be built even if VITR is not built."

The original of this letter will be delivered by courier to the Commission. Copies will also be provided to all parties to the proceeding consistent with the requirements of the Commission's document filing protocols.
