By letter dated December 28, 2004 (Exhibit C17-2), counsel for Duke Point Power Limited Partnership ("DPP") requests that BCTC provide a witness to speak to evidence it has put on the record in response to Information Requests, Exhibit C6-2. By letter dated December 29, 2004 (Exhibit C6-3), BCTC responded to the DPP request.
