This is in response to your September 15, 2005 letter, in which you request an extension to the October 7, 2005 deadline for submitting Intervenor Evidence that is set out in the Regulatory Timetable that was Appendix A to Order No. G-72-05.

In the letter, you also express concern about the information in BCTC's responses to Information Requests. Any particular concerns about the adequacy of responses to specific Information Requests should be raised in writing to the Commission as soon as possible.

In the letter, you also request clarification whether you can submit additional Information Requests to BCTC, outside of the schedule set out in the Regulatory Timetable. You may submit such additional Information Requests, however BCTC may object and not respond to the Information Requests. In any case, it seems unlikely that BCTC would be able to respond to such additional Information Requests by September 27, 2005 and perhaps not until after the date for filing Intervenor Evidence. Alternatively, you may have the opportunity to clarify the responses to Information Requests through the cross-examination of BCTC witnesses. The Commission denies your request for an extension to the deadline for submitting Intervenor Evidence.

On a related matter, it is not apparent that your September 15, 2005 letter was copied to BCTC or other Intervenors. All Intervenors are reminded that they are responsible for copying all submissions in the proceeding to the Commission, BCTC and all other Intervenors.
