Re: April 3, 2006 BCTC Proposal to Change Argument Filing Dates - Reply to Mr. Carpenter's April 6, 2006 letter

In reply to Mr. Carpenter's letter of today's date, Sea Breeze is compelled to register its concern about BCTC's objection to our request that BCTC be required to file, at this time, a complete explanation of the reasons for the present delay in the cable tendering process (as set out in our letter of yesterday's date).

The information which we have requested in this report is, in our submission, necessary to enable intervenors to file arguments on the VITR Application by the present deadline of April 19, 2006. Without that information, the record will not be sufficiently complete for intervenors to properly address issues related to the costs and risks involved in the VITR proposal.

Accordingly, if BCTC is not required to file the report we have requested at this time explaining the delay in the cable tendering process, Sea Breeze must support the submission by IRAHVOL that the deadline for filing of intervenor arguments should be changed to be one week after the revised date for filing Mr. Nelson's report.

Assuming that the deadline for filing Mr. Nelson's report will be May 2, 2006 (as BCTC has now agreed), that would effectively result in the filing date for intervenor arguments being moved to May 9, 2006.
