for the Advanced Metering Infrastructure ("AMI") Project

By a letter dated March 28, 2008 (Exhibit B-6), FortisBC advised that it continued to engage in public consultation with stakeholders, including the Ministry of Energy, Mines and Petroleum Resources. FortisBC also advised that it was of the opinion that additional benefits in support of the BC Energy Plan could be provided with the addition of functionality not included with the original application and sought approval for an amended application to address the inclusion of this additional functionality ("the Amended Application").

In a News Released dated March 31, 2008, the Minister of Energy, Mines and Petroleum Resources announced Bill 15-2008, The Utilities Commission Amendment Act, 2008 ("Bill 15"). Bill 15 includes provisions which may be relevant to the Amended Application. Therefore, the Commission requests FortisBC to confirm the Amended Application or, in the alternative, provide any additional amendments to the Amended Application. The Commission also requests further comments on the Regulatory Timetable, specifically whether or not the Regulatory Timetable proposed by FortisBC in Exhibit B-6 should be delayed so that the Information Requests and Submissions are due following the enactment of Bill 15.

The Commission requests comments from Intervenors on the FortisBC response, which are requested to be filed within 5 business days of the date of the FortisBC response. The Commission expects to issue an Amended Regulatory Timetable once Intervenor comments are filed.
