The City of Langford writes further to BCUC Order No. G-22-17 and the BCUC’s letter dated May 11, 2017.

In the above-described letter the Panel set out the date of May 17, 2017 as the filing date for the City of Langford to respond to the Panel’s request concerning clarification of certain information submitted in BCUC’s Information Request 4.1. The question posed by the Panel appears to seek a more complete “inventory” response that will require review of relevant plans, and survey information relating to the infrastructure. We must also consider whether such a response is possible. The City of Langford will have to review a number of documents to answer this question. Further, the City of Langford has been allotted 4 business days to respond to the Panel’s question. In light of the required document review to answer this question and the short period of time allotted for response, the City of Langford will not be able to meet this deadline. Accordingly, we request that such timeline be extended to May 31, 2017.

The above letter also requires that Round 1 Submissions from SSL and Registered Interveners on Further Process (“**Round 1**”) be submitted by May 18th and Round 2 Submissions from SSL and Registered Interveners on Further Process (“**Round 2**”) be submitted by May 25th, 2017. Having regard to the City of Langford’s scheduling constraints and the short timeframe allotted we will not be able to meet the filing date for Round 1. We have been advised by counsel for SSL-Sustainable Services Ltd. that she will be away between the dates of May 27 and June 11.
