Dear Mr. Landale:

The British Columbia Utilities Commission (Commission) is in receipt of your November 2, 2017 request for a two-day extension to the intervener information request (IR) No. 1 deadline of November 6, 2017, pursuant to the Regulatory Timetable established by Order G-156-17 for the above-noted proceeding. In your request, you indicate that your access to a computer is limited at this time because your home computer is undergoing repairs.

The Panel considered the request. The Panel views that granting an extension to the intervener IR No. 1 deadline and modifying the current timetable would not be warranted from a cost perspective. The Panel encourages you to make arrangements as needed in order to meet the current intervener IR No.1 deadline.

However, under these extraordinary circumstances, if you are not able to meet the November 6, 2017 deadline, the Panel will accept your IRs and request that ICBC respond to these interrogatories on a best efforts basis.
