Further to the filing of its response to the Round 1 Information Requests, ICBC notes that the following content has been redacted because it contains sensitive information:

1. 2017.1 RR BCUC.14.1, Attachment A – BI Segmented Analysis as of May 2017 (Redacted Version) is partially redacted because of confidential content.
2. 2017.1 RR BCUC.10.9: the response to this information request is partially redacted to remove confidential content reproduced from the unredacted version of Attachment A – BI Segmented Analysis as of May 2017 (Redacted Version) filed in response to information request 2017.1 RR BCUC.14.1.

The confidential information, if made public, could influence settlement negotiations with claimants and prejudice ICBC and its Basic insurance policyholders and thereby harm ICBC's financial interest. Both documents also contain data that is only available on a total basis (Basic insurance and Optional insurance combined).

ICBC is filing unredacted content under separate confidential cover, filed contemporaneously with this letter, and is respectfully requesting that it be treated as confidential in a manner consistent with Commission guidelines.
