Re: British Columbia Utilities Commission (the Commission) – An Inquiry into the Regulation of Electric Vehicle Charging Service – Project Number 1598941 – Phase 2

By order number G-50-19, the Commission made revisions to the scope of the matters to be considered in Phase 2 of the Inquiry and established a regulatory timetable for the filing of final arguments and reply arguments on that revised scope. The Commission noted that many parties had already provided their arguments and requested that unnecessary repetition in final arguments be avoided.
