



NEWS RELEASE – Update on BC Hydro SAP Inquiry

November 23, 2016

The BC Utilities Commission has ordered BC Hydro to collect and submit more information about decisions related to their SAP software platform.

The order is an update to the inquiry the BC Utilities Commission launched in April 2016 following a complaint from MLA Adrian Dix.

During the inquiry BC Hydro acknowledged that there are gaps in the information they have provided because they have not been able to gain full insight into employees' decisions in 2008 and 2009 related to SAP.

Today's order directs BC Hydro to provide the Commission with written statements from current and past employees who were involved in SAP-related decisions around 2008 and 2009. These statements will address questions about BC Hydro's SAP-related decisions including who approved aspects of the SAP project and which information was disclosed to the Commission.

Once these statements are submitted by BC Hydro, the BC Utilities Commission will determine what, if any, further process may be required, including whether an oral hearing should be held.
