Dear Sir/Madam.

I register as a intervener.

Apparently there is a document submitted by BC Hydro that is currently under review by your corporation. This has just been brought to my attention. The link on-line is http://www.bcuc.com/Documents/Proceedings/2015/DOC_44664_B-1-BCH-2015-Rate-Design-Appl.pdf.

This is a 4900 page document that requires a public review before this can be rebutted if necessary. BC Hydro has not advised the public as required as a crown corporation. **An extension of 6 months is requested** in order for the appropriate and required public review to occur.

One item that needs to be in this document that seems to be missing is the lowering or elimination of legacy meter fees. Arbitrary failed meter installation fees also need to be addressed. There is also the trend towards time of use billing and more detailed metering that also needs to be dissected from this document if present. This will result in even higher electrical bills than we have received since the installation of the Smart Meter. A closer review is required and that cannot be accomplished in the short time presented at this late stage from BC Hydro never consulting the general public that are the shareholders of BC Hydro.

The government are trustees for the public and it is the public that have the final approval of any requested changes with BC Hydro a crown corporation.
