Dear Commissioner Hamilton,

- 1) I would like to submit a complaint about the outrageous and unfair amount of money I am being charged every month as a 'Legacy Fee' in order for me to retain my Analog Meter and to have a Meter Reader come out to read my meter every second month (6 times) a year.
  
- 2) I am a single mom, my wages have remained the same for the past 5 years (no raises) and yet BC Hydro rates will have gone up 28% in just 5 years (from 2013 to 2017). Add to that the Legacy fees I pay monthly, which is another 25% increase to my bill, I will have a 50% increase to my Hydro bill by the time 2017 comes around.
  
- 3) Legacy fees in BC are the highest in all of Canada at \$32.40 a month, with no solid reason behind it.
  
- 4) Why am I paying a legacy fee to have my meter read when Smart Meter customers are not being charged for a meter reader to come to their home and read their Smart Meter?
  
- 5) I am being punished for choosing to keep my Analog Meter because I have valid concerns about the health risks from wireless Smart Meters.

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
