Further to your request requesting further information on the issues Kwadacha Nations intends to pursue and the extent of the anticipated involvement in the review process, below is our response.

BC Hydro has presented 3 options for Zone II rates which will be further discussed as part of Module 2 of the BC Hydro Rate Design Application. These options include the following:

- Maintain Status Quo
- Full Cost Recovery
- Equalize Zone II/Zone IB and Zone I rates

It is therefore essential for Zone II ratepayers to be involved in Module 1 of the RDA as these issues will inform Module 2.

Kwadacha Nation is a Zone II ratepayer with residential (rate 1107) and small general service (rate 1234) rate schedules. Therefore in Module 1 of the RDA, Kwadacha Nation intends to pursue issues associated with:

- Cost of Service
- Postage Stamp Rates
- Residential Service Rates
- General Service Rates

In terms of its anticipated involvement, Kwadacha Nation intends to participate actively in the RDA proceedings.

As we are currently in communications with other Zone II non-integrated areas and anticipate that they may join this intervention, we request that the intervention be registered as the "Zone II Ratepayers Group."
