Ms. Hamilton:

It has been brought to my attention that Sharon Noble, a person of outstanding character and one who has proven herself constantly and consistently to be both a knowledgeable person in matters before the committee and a person of integrity worthy to represent our position on the matters at hand, has been denied intervenor status in the coming hearings.

I am here to demand representation in these hearings by allowing Ms. Noble's intervenor status to be reinstated. We, as citizens of Canada and of British Columbia, have been subject to discriminatory and punitive treatment contrary to BCUC regulations and the Canadian Charter of Rights and Freedoms with regards to the smart meter program. Don't think that we will allow you or anyone to wipe their feet on our Constitution or Charter of rights for much longer. Refusing Ms. Noble's intervenor status in these matters before the committee only adds another violation to the already mounting and compounding assaults on our rights as free citizens. These assaults have and will neither go unnoticed nor unpunished... for as long as it takes for us to right these wrongs and bring those involved in this outrage to justice.
