I'm sickened by Hydro's self-serving document.

Given

That the terms "servant" and "shall," having legal meanings different than the terms "representative" and "will," should on no account be changed

The control of electricity and water are vital to the control of people and to the Agenda 21 process of moving rural dwellers to cities. The difficulties in achieving it aren't just local, but exist in most other provinces and countries, yet Hydro's current and future ownership of dams and transmission facilities will make it major continental asset. Unfortunately the non-elected and corporate Agenda 21 leaders have not invited the populace to participate in the process, so BC Hydro, whoever its future ownership, will be a major asset to the continental power grid but with no avenue for public input.

Both of BC's current political parties have used the taxing of Hydro, a corporation the government owns, to cover government expenditures. Though legal, some might consider this a questionable practice, and one which might eventually cause a debt-ridden Hydro to be sold cheaply to outside interests – perhaps Itron, who make the dangerous and problematic "smartmeters" and who have developed software to control both the meters and the continental power grid.

Given the above, and without going into detail which I'm sure you understand already, I urge that BC Hydro's application be rejected as unacceptable because it would create a corporation that is responsible for nothing and responsible to no one.
