

**RE: British Columbia Hydro and Power Authority 2015 Rate Design Application
Commission Request for Intervener Comments Regarding Modified Timetable**

Please be advised that we continue to represent the Movement of United Professionals (MoveUP) and we make the following comments on their behalf regarding the RDA's Oral Hearing Dates.

We have reviewed the relevant documents, including but not limited to BC Hydro's submission, the Commission's April 6, 2016 letter now marked as exhibit A-25 and BCOAPO's March 31, 2016 letter (exhibit C2-9). Due to BC Hydro and the Commission's efforts to discuss the possible timing and duration of the oral hearing with the affected parties, MoveUP supports the timetable presented with one caveat. Given the potential volume of issues that may remain in play and the uncertainty regarding how long it may take to deal with BCOAPO's LICO rate proposals, the Union joins BCOAPO in asking that the Commission request that all parties keep August 25 and 26, 2016 free should the hearing not conclude within the allotted time.
