Please state your reasons for intervening in this proceeding.

I made the initial complaint to the decision under review and consider the issue to be of the utmost seriousness for ratepayers, the Commission, BC Hydro, its employees and the people of BC. As noted in my complaint, I believe the Commission was misled by BC Hydro with respect to Information Technology programs, in particular SAP. Further, that the consequences of this deception and poor implementation of IT programs have been profound for ratepayers. This is a case study of how not to implement IT programs.

As the initial complainant with relevant information and analysis to bring to the inquiry, I believe I have a duty to

continue to take part, even as this matter has evolved from my complaint to a full BCUC Inquiry.
