- 2. Net metering Billing

I am directly affected by the outcome of this proceeding.

The Commission's decision on this matter will directly affect the manner in which my utility bill is calculated and the remuneration rate paid. The applicant, FortisBC Inc., is requesting to change the the rate paid for surplus power from the present contract:

- 1. Time of Use rate low rate 0.06212 \$/kWhr
- 2. Time of Use high rate 0.19181 \$/kWhr

to the lower rate of 0.04303 \$/kWhr

This represents a reduction of 31 % reduction of the low rate and a 77 % reduction from the high rate.

Please list the key issues you intend to address in the proceeding.

Key issues.

- 1. Method of billing calculation.
- 2. Rate of remuneration payed for power generated, but not consumed, under the Net Billing and Time of Use programs.
- 3. The need to "Grandfather" customers who, after signing up for one contract in good faith, made significant costly equipment modifications, would now be forced to participate in a substantially reduced contract should the application be approved.
