On June 30, 2016, the British Columbia Utilities Commission (Commission) sought submissions from all parties on the review process for the Commercial Energy Consumers Association of British Columbia’s (CEC’s) proposal to establish a non-firm interruptible rate pilot for medium and large general service customers (Exhibit A-33).

Parties were requested to provide submissions on the need for a procedural conference to discuss process and procedures for the review of CEC’s evidence, whether there was a preference for written submissions, or whether the submissions should be brought forward on the first day of the oral hearing scheduled for August 16, 2016.

By the deadline of Thursday, July 7, 2016, the Commission received submissions from British Columbia Hydro and Power Authority and the majority of registered interveners. No parties have indicated a need for a procedural conference. Many parties have indicated a preference that these procedural matters should not be raised at the first day of the oral hearing. Accordingly, the Commission determines that the most efficient method to discuss the review process for CEC’s proposal is through written submissions following the timetable below:
