Re: FortisBC Net Metering Tariff Update Application

With respect to the Commission Order G-94-16 to provide comments on further process of the FBC Net Metering update, we have the following observations;

After reviewing FBC's response to various interveners information requests it does appear that FortisBC is reluctant or perhaps in miss-understanding of the posed questions and have failed a number of times to provide information to satisfy these requests.

The Net Metering program is a key element to future electrical energy planning and provision for the citizens of British Columbia, and the success of participant take-up could be impacted by decisions made under this application update.

We propose the Commission opt for one of the following;

1. The Commission review each intervener information request and decide whether in their view the question should / could have been addressed in a more satisfactory manner and re-pose the question to FBC, this will allow dialogue to identify and address any miss understanding of the initial request.
2. Allow for a second round of information requests to proceed to satisfy interveners who feel that initial requests need to be restructured and posed again to gain a more conclusive answer.
