How to apply

1. Review the terms and conditions (PDF, 194 KB).
2. Find a qualifying heat pump model.
3. Install your new heat pump.
4. Complete the necessary application form(s):
 - o Do you own the home and have the BC Hydro account in your name? Complete the homeowner application form (PDF, 1 MB).
 - o Are you a landlord making upgrades to your rental property? Complete the landlord/tenant application form (PDF, 1.0 MB). If you don't pay the BC Hydro bill for the property, have the tenant complete Form B Tenant consent form (PDF, 723 KB) and submit to the address below (separately from your application form).
5. Include a copy of your invoice(s) showing details of all work performed, including the purchase date, make, model and installation permit numbers (if applicable) with your application and send to the address below.

Looking to switch from oil heat to an electric air source heat pump?

Additional rebates are available if you're switching from oil heating to an electric air source heat pump. The program is an initiative of the Province of British Columbia to accelerate the adoption of heat pumps and replace less efficient oil heating systems in order to achieve greenhouse gas reductions, prevent oil tank leaks, and improve home energy efficiency.
