If it is that easy for us to cross into the second tier, it must be almost impossible for a family to stay in the first tier.

Living in our home, within our means, is important. There are people who do not conserve and probably do not pay attention to the electricity bill, but we do.

Recommendations: Increase the tier one kWh up to a "fair" level and/or make the tier two rate an reasonable amount.
