Re: Insurance Corporation of British Columbia
2017 Revenue Requirements Application – Project No. 1598929

On December 18, 2017, the Lieutenant Governor in Council issued Order in Council No. 602 (OIC 602/17) amending Special Direction IC2 to the British Columbia Utilities Commission (Special Direction IC2). OIC 602/17 requires the British Columbia Utilities Commission (Commission) to issue, for the 2017 policy year, the following orders to the Insurance Corporation of British Columbia (ICBC) by January 12, 2018, based on the evidence filed with the Commission by December 12, 2017:

- i. its final general rate change order; and
- ii. any other final orders in respect of ICBC's revenue requirements application that was filed with the Commission on September 15, 2017.

As a result, the Panel considers that establishing an amended regulatory timetable is required due to the amendments to Special Direction IC2 set out in OIC 602/17. The Regulatory Timetable will proceed directly to written final and reply arguments, as set out in the attached Appendix A to Order G-192-17. For reference, OIC 602/17 is attached as Appendix B to Order G-192-17.

Due to the timelines contained in OIC 602/17, the Panel appreciates the receipt of arguments in an expedited manner. ICBC is requested to copy all interveners on its written final argument, and interveners are requested to copy ICBC on its final arguments. The parties are advised that the Panel will not consider extension requests to the amended timetable.

The Panel will consider the arguments received when issuing its orders related to ICBC's 2017 Revenue Requirements application.

Due to the circumstances, the Panel views that Participant Assistance/Cost Award (PACA) budget estimates are no longer necessary. The Panel requests participants to proceed directly to filing PACA applications by no later than Thursday, January 18, 2018.

ORDER

WHEREAS:

- A. On September 15, 2017, the Insurance Corporation of British Columbia (ICBC) filed an application with the British Columbia Utilities Commission (Commission) for its 2017 Revenue Requirements for Universal Compulsory Automobile Insurance (Basic insurance), seeking a Basic insurance rate increase of 6.4 percent for the policy year commencing November 1, 2017, among other requests (Application);
- B. By Orders G-146-17, G-156-17, and G-180-17, the Commission established a regulatory timetable for the review of the Application, which included intervenor and interested party registration, two rounds of information requests, a Procedural Conference, a process for intervenor evidence, and written final and reply arguments;
- C. On December 18, 2017, the Lieutenant Governor in Council issued Order in Council No. 602 (OIC 602/17) amending Special Direction IC2 to the British Columbia Utilities Commission (Special Direction IC2). OIC 602/17 requires the Commission to issue, for the 2017 policy year, the following orders to ICBC by January 12, 2018, based on the evidence filed with the Commission by December 12, 2017:
 - i. its final general rate change order; and
 - ii. any other final orders in respect of ICBC's revenue requirements application that was filed with the Commission on September 15, 2017; and

D. The Commission considers that establishing an amended regulatory timetable is required due to the amendments to Special Direction IC2 set out in OIC 602/17.

NOW THEREFORE the Commission orders that the Regulatory Timetable established by Order G-180-17 is amended, as set out in Appendix A to this order.
