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Comment:

I have owned an electric vehicle for 4 years in the North. I would like to see a network of electric vehicle charging stations (level 2 or fast charge) along major routes across the province (Hwy 16, Hwy 97, Hwy 5, etc) to make it feasible to travel long distances. This network should take into account the average range of electric vehicles. Ideally, the charging stations should be located near amenities (coffee shops, etc), but in more remote areas local parks or rest areas could be used. Charging should be tied to the cost of KW used. Please remember that not all electric vehicles are located in major urban centers. I would also like to see standardization/interoperability on fast charge outlets.
