Dear Sirs/Mesdames:

Re: FortisBC Alternative Energy Services Inc. 2018/2019 Revenue Requirements and Cost of Service Rates Application for the Thermal Energy Service to Delta School District No. 37 (the “Application”)

We are the solicitors to Delta School District No. 37 (“DSD”) and write further to our telephone call regarding the above-noted matter on 24 April 2018.

On April 5 2018, DSD attended a procedural conference regarding the Application. We understand that the Commission rendered a decision on 12 April 2018, and notified FAES of that decision. We confirm that, to date, we have not received any notice of the Commission’s decision. To that end, we only just learned of the Commission’s decision by independently checking the Commission’s website on 24 April 2018.

The effect of the foregoing is that:

1. DSD only has one day to prepare and file an application to intervene in the Application proceedings (DSD learned of the Decision on 24 April 2018 and the deadline for filing an application to intervene in the Application proceedings is 25 April 2018).
2. DSD has less time than FAES to prepare for the other steps in the Application proceedings.

In light of the foregoing, we respectfully request that the Commission extend all of the deadlines set out in the regulatory timetable for the Application proceedings by twelve (12) days (i.e. by the amount of time during which we did not have notice of the Decision).

Please advise us of the Commission's decision regarding our request at your earliest convenience and, with respect to our request for an extension of today's deadline, by this afternoon so that we may file a brief intervention application, if needed.
