We write as counsel for Western LNG (Western) in connection with the BCUC Order No. G-116-18 issued June 26, 2018 in connection with the Application.

Order No. G-116-18 establishes a firm schedule for BCUC and intervenor Information Requests (IRs) to Pacific Northern Gas Ltd. (PNG) and for PNG's responses to IRs. The Order also identifies a tentative date for a streamlined review process with oral final arguments and a tentative date for written reply argument. As it currently stands, the process identified does not expressly identify an opportunity for intervenor evidence.

Western wishes to advise the Commission that its current intention is to seek the opportunity to file an expert report and lead intervenor evidence. As currently outlined, the tentative process established by the Commission may not conveniently accommodate these important procedural steps. While Western will not be able to make a final determination in this regard until responses to its IRs are received from PNG on July 19, 2018, it wishes to advise the Applicant and the Commission now of its current intention to file expert evidence and lead intervenor evidence. Western will confirm its request in this regard as soon as is practicable after receiving PNG's IR responses.
