**Re: Pacific Northern Gas Ltd. (PNG)

Submission on Filing of Intervener Evidence**

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In accordance with the Commission's letter dated July 11, 2018, please find below PNG's submission and comments on Western LNG LLC (WLNG)'s request to file intervener evidence and a proposed regulatory timetable.

1. Comment on WLNG's request to file intervener evidence:

Although unexpected, PNG is amenable for the Commission to grant WLNG's request to file intervener evidence which includes expert evidence in the proceeding. However, PNG would also request that it be granted the opportunity to file reply evidence if required as well as one round of Information Requests to WLNG.

2. Proposed Revised Regulatory Timetable (including action items and dates of completion) in the event that the request to file evidence is approved:

PNG submits that having had the opportunity to review the number and content of the information requests, it does not appear that a streamlined review process would be of benefit in resolving the matter or in accordance with the Commission's guidelines. The evidentiary matters can and should be addressed in written form given the comprehensive and precise nature of the questions posed, and the legal issues raised would benefit from the sequential exchange of written arguments as proposed below.

In addition, due to higher than expected number of Information Requests received as well as PNG's limited availability of resources, PNG is requesting for an extension of an additional

three working days to file its responses to the BCUC and Intervener IRs. PNG proposes the regulatory process to follow a written hearing process and the following timetable:


PNG also notes that if WLNG decides not to file any intervener evidence, as indicated in their letter dated July 10, 2018, PNG proposes the following timetable:
