Dear Mr. Liu,

This letter is in response to your email request dated September 13, 2018 to file written intervener final arguments on September 17, 2018.

As stated in the Panel’s letter dated August 30, 2018 (Exhibit A-4), interveners who are unable to attend the oral arguments in-person may participate either by teleconference or filing a written final argument by no later than September 5, 2018. The argument phase closed with Insurance Corporation of British Columbia’s (ICBC) oral reply arguments on September 6, 2018. An exception was made in the case of Toward Responsible Educated Attentive Driving (TREAD) after the Panel heard submissions from its counsel at the Streamlined Review Process and only with agreement of ICBC and the other interveners who were present.

The Panel also notes that your request dated September 13, 2018 is made one week after the oral arguments concluded. There was no notice to the British Columbia Utilities Commission prior to September 6, 2018 that you were unable to attend the oral arguments in-person or wished to make other arrangements.

For these reasons, your request is declined.
