Re: FortisBC Energy Inc. Application to Exclude Employee Information from 2015 Data Order G-161-15 - Project No. 1598960 - Regulatory Timetable

We are counsel for FEI in the above noted proceeding. We write in respect of the revised order G-183-18.

The order provides a timeline for further submissions on jurisdiction. In our client's respectful submission, the parties have already filed extensive submissions on jurisdiction in the full expectation that this would conclude the hearing on the preliminary question. Despite MoveUP's proposal to postpone the Commission's determination, MoveUP had filed full and detailed substantive submissions as well on August 10. FEI had replied in detail. The additional steps put in place (further reply from FEI, a sur-reply by MoveUP and a sur-sur reply from FEI), without appropriate ground rules, raise the potential for considerable inefficiency in the process.

We can advise that FEI will not be filing further submissions in anticipation of the date indicated for FEI's Final Submission on Jurisdiction (October 7), as we have already replied sufficiently to MoveUP's August 10 submissions.

Given the extent of the submissions so far, we respectfully ask that the Commission maintain tight parameters around any sur-reply submissions (October 21) from MoveUP. If such submissions are required at all, they should be limited to matters that are truly new and unanticipated. We will, of course, do the same in respect of FEI's sur-sur reply (October 28).
