Errata to the **CONFIDENTIAL Response to British Columbia Utilities Commission (BCUC) Information Request (IR) No. 1 – Question 12.2**

On May 8, 2018, FBC filed its response to BCUC IR No. 1 in the above noted proceeding. It has come to FBC's attention that a correction is required with respect to a table filed confidentially in the response to response to BCUC IR 1.12.2 (Exhibit B-9). FBC acknowledges that the record for the Application is closed; however, we are bringing this to the attention of the BCUC and interveners for accuracy and future reference.

Specifically, page 40 of the public response to BCUC IR 1.12.2 contains a table (Table 1) which was redacted and filed confidentially with the BCUC. Table 1 summarizes billing information for 2016 for Zellstoff Celgar Limited Partnership (Celgar). FBC has realized that some of the entries for certain months reported in the table (and therefore certain totals) did not accurately reflect the actual billings to Celgar. To be clear, the bills issued to Celgar were accurate and correct; it is simply Table 1 that did not in certain months reflect the actual amounts. The differences between the bills and the entries at issue in Table 1 are not material, and do not in any way impact the Application or approvals sought. The changes also do not impact the second portion of Table 1, which remains accurate. The specific entries to Table 1 that have been corrected are shown in the attached errata highlighted in yellow.

FBC notes that the bottom portion of Table 1 is drawn from different sources than the top, and slight variances between the top and bottom portions are primarily due to rounding.

A corrected version of the confidential portion of the response to BCUC IR 1.12.2 is being filed confidentially with the BCUC and will also be provided to representatives from Celgar who have signed confidentiality declarations and undertakings.
