Dear Mr. Slater:

By Orders G-77-18, G-83-18 and G-118-18, the British Columbia Utilities Commission (BCUC) established a regulatory timetable for the above-noted proceeding. The final item in the regulatory timetable – FortisBC Alternative Energy Services Inc. (FAES) response to BCUC and Delta School District No. 37 (DSD) information requests (IRs) on FAES rebuttal evidence – is due on Thursday, November 8, 2018.

The BCUC invites FAES and DSD to make submissions on the remainder of the regulatory process, including the following:

- Whether there is a need for additional IRs on the evidence already presented on the record.
- Whether an oral hearing is necessary and why. Parties that specify a need for an oral hearing must indicate what topic(s) should be included in the oral hearing and which witnesses would be providing testimony, and hence be available for cross examination.
- Whether the argument phase should be in written or oral form.

In addition to submissions on the above topics, parties are requested to provide proposed regulatory timetables based on their proposed process.

All submissions should be filed via the BCUC’s website, for consideration by the Panel, in accordance with the following timetable:
