ICBC is forwarding Ernst & Young LLP's January 21, 2019 errata letter listing corrections required with respect to Technical Appendix E.0, Product Reform Costing Report (Ernst & Young LLP, November 2018). The errata letter includes the corrected excerpts of Technical Appendix E.0. The errata letter and the corrected excerpts of Technical Appendix E.0 contain information that ICBC previously identified as confidential in its December 14, 2018 cover letter to the 2019 Revenue Requirements Application (Exhibits B-1). This information, if disclosed, could harm ICBC's financial interest.

The unredacted and marked as confidential errata letter and the corrected excerpts of Technical Appendix E.0 are filed herein under this cover letter. ICBC respectfully requests that the unredacted errata letter and the corrected excerpts of Technical Appendix E.0 filed be treated as confidential in a manner consistent with the British Columbia Utilities Commission's guidelines.

ICBC has prepared a redacted version of the errata letter and the corrected excerpts of Technical Appendix E.0, and has filed them contemporaneously under a separate cover letter.

These changes have no impact on the rate change to cover costs or on the proposed rate change of 6.3%.
