**Re: FortisBC Energy Inc. – Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity Application for the Inland Gas Upgrade Project – Project No. 1598988 – Submission Request on Further Process**

Dear Mr. Slater:

By Order G-11-19 dated January 17, 2019, the British Columbia Utilities Commission (BCUC) established a regulatory timetable for the FortisBC Energy Inc. (FEI) Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity Application for the Inland Gas Upgrade Project (Application). The regulatory timetable included, among other things, one round of BCUC and intervener information requests (IRs) followed by submissions on further process. The Panel requests that parties address the following (with reasons in support) as part of their submissions on further process:

1. Whether a second round of IRs is required;
2. Whether parties intend to submit evidence (if so, please describe the nature of that evidence);
3. If other processes such as a workshop, streamlined review process and/or oral hearing should be considered by the Panel (if so, given the complexity of the Application, please specify the area(s) in the Application that should be included as part of the proposed process); and
4. A proposed timeline for all of the aforementioned processes, including parties' periods of unavailability during the remainder of 2019.

In accordance with the regulatory timetable established by Order G-11-19, parties' submissions on further process, including the aforementioned issues, must be filed electronically on or before Thursday, April 4, 2019. FEI may (but is not required to) file a reply submission if it chooses to do so on or before Monday, April 8, 2019. Following receipt of the submissions and reply, if any, the BCUC will issue an order establishing further process.
