Dear Ms. Elder:

On March 8, 2019, the Insurance Corporation of British Columbia (ICBC) filed confidential responses to certain British Columbia Utilities Commission (BCUC) and registered intervener information requests (IRs) for the above-noted proceeding (Exhibit B-2-1). On March 29, 2019, the BCUC received a letter from Mr. McCandless (Exhibit C3-4) requesting the Panel direct ICBC to publicly file the redacted information in response to 2019.1 RR RM.3.8C (McCandless IR 3.8), which was included in Exhibit B-2-1.

In the request, Mr. McCandless provides a number of reasons objecting to the confidentiality of the redacted information related to total settlement awards and average settlement (severity) awards per exposure or claim for 2012, 2015, 2016/17, 2017/18 and 2018/19 Forecast for unrepresented, represented but not litigated, and litigated claims.

Part IV, Section 21.03 of the BCUC’s [Rules of Practice and Procedure](#) provides that the party claiming confidentiality is to be provided with the opportunity to reply to an objection to confidentiality. The Panel invites written comments from ICBC in response to Mr. McCandless’ request by **Thursday, April 4, 2019**.

Mr. McCandless will then be given the opportunity to reply to the comments provided by ICBC by **Monday, April 8, 2019**.
