**Re: British Columbia Hydro and Power Authority – F2020 to F2021 Revenue Requirements Application
Project No. 1598990 – Procedural Conference Information**

Dear Mr. James:

British Columbia Utilities Commission (BCUC) Order G-45-19 established a Procedural Conference for the above-noted proceeding to take place on June 24, 2019, commencing at 9:00 am in the BCUC Hearing Room, 12th Floor, 1125 Howe Street, Vancouver, BC.

The purpose of the Procedural Conference is to hear from the applicant and registered interveners on the following matters:

1. Whether the Peace Region Electric Supply Project¹ meets the requirements to be considered a prescribed undertaking under section 18 of the *Clean Energy Act*, pursuant to Section 4(2) of the Greenhouse Gas Reduction (Clean Energy) Regulation. Only preliminary submissions are required at this time.
2. Whether the MIN to LNG Canada Interconnection Project meets the requirements of the Transmission Upgrade Exemption Regulation, as amended by B.C. Reg. 160/2018, to exempt the project from Part 3 of the *Utilities Commission Act*.² Only preliminary submissions are required at this time.
3. Whether it is the interveners' intention to file intervenor evidence and if so, relating to what specific matters.
4. Whether the review of the F2020 to F2021 Revenue Requirements Application (RRA) should proceed by a written or oral public hearing, or some other process.
5. Steps and timetable associated with the recommended regulatory review process. If you are proposing an oral public hearing, please identify the specific matter(s) that should be addressed through that process and the rationale.

6. Any other matter that will assist the BCUC to efficiently review the RRA.

If BC Hydro or the other parties consider it more efficient to provide submissions in writing prior to the Procedural Conference, they are invited to do so on or before **12:00 pm, Wednesday, June 19, 2019**. All submissions should be filed electronically via the BCUC's eFiling system.

Participants are requested to inform the Commission Secretary, at Commission.Secretary@bcuc.com, to confirm their attendance at the Procedural Conference by **June 20, 2019**.

Intervenors who wish to participate by Telephone Conference should notify Hal Bemister at Allwest Reporting (604-683-4774) prior to the Procedural Conference.

After the Procedural Conference, the BCUC will issue a further procedural order and regulatory timetable for the review of the RRA. If you have any questions, please contact the undersigned for more information.
