**Re: BC Hydro F2020-F2021 Revenue Requirements Application -
Regulatory Schedule**

On behalf of Kwadacha Nation and Tsay Keh Dene Nation (aka. Zone II Ratepayers Group (“**Zone II RPG**”)), we write in response to the Commission’s letters dated August 2 and 15, 2019 (Exhibits A-10 and A-11 respectively). We appreciate the brief extension in time to file this letter.

Zone II RPG is amenable to re-scheduling the next procedural conference on either November 22, 2019 (afternoon) or December 19, 2019 (morning). We are in agreement with BC Hydro that the earlier date will allow the parties additional time to prepare for the oral component of the proceeding especially in light of the Christmas holiday period.

Although Zone II RPG does not object to rescheduling the next procedural conference, a final decision on whether specific intervenor evidence is in scope for the oral hearing should be left until after submission of that evidence to the Commission.
