FEI BIOGAS PURCHASE AGREEMENT BETWEEN FEI AND THE COV EXHIBIT A-11

To: FortisBC Energy Inc. & Registered Interveners

Re: FortisBC Energy Inc. – Application for Acceptance of the Biogas Purchase Agreement Between FortisBC Energy Inc. and the City of Vancouver– Project No. 1598977 –Streamlined Review Process

By Order G-223-19 dated September 12, 2019, the British Columbia Utilities Commission (BCUC) established a further regulatory process with respect to the above-noted application. This letter provides additional information regarding the upcoming Streamlined Review Process (SRP).

General information

Interveners are requested to email the Commission Secretary at Commission.Secretary@bcuc.com to confirm their attendance at the SRP **by 12:00 p.m. (Pacific Time) on Thursday, September 19, 2019**. Interveners who wish to participate via teleconference must test their connections prior to the commencement of the sessions.

The SRP will be conducted via live webcast and verbatim transcripts for the SRP will be recorded. Transcripts are considered evidence and placed on the public record of the proceeding and the BCUC's website. Participants are expected to conduct themselves in a respectful manner and speak at a reasonable volume and speed (one person speaking at a time) to make transcription possible.

Any part of the process outlined below may be modified by the Panel to suit the participants, or to allow for a better understanding of the issues.

Streamlined Review Process

The SRP will commence at **9:00 a.m. (Pacific Time) on Wednesday, September 25, 2019 at Allwest Reporting** (12th Floor, 1125 Howe Street, Vancouver, BC V6Z 2K8). As set out in the BCUC's [SRP Policy, Guidelines and Procedures](#), participation in the SRP includes the applicant, registered interveners, the Panel and BCUC staff.

The topic in scope for the SRP is FortisBC Energy Inc.'s (FEI) proposed mechanism to provide the required certainty that FEI's RNG acquisition cost is within the specified cost threshold, including the need for a deferral account and circumstances where RNG acquisition costs will be borne by the shareholder.

In accordance with the regulatory timetable established in Order G-223-19, FEI will respond to written questions submitted by the participants either in advance of, or at the SRP. Parties will have the opportunity to ask questions during the SRP.

The SRP will proceed as follows:

1. The Panel Chair will make an opening statement and comment on procedural matters for the day;
2. Participants will register with the hearing officer. After introductions of the participants, FEI is invited to provide an initial presentation on in-scope topics of the SRP. Questions of clarification may be asked during the initial presentation, as necessary. Before asking any questions, participants should first identify themselves for the transcription record;
3. FEI may make a presentation on items within the scope of the SRP, as it is described above. FEI is requested to limit its initial presentation to no longer than thirty minutes in order to allow time for the subsequent question and response period;
4. FEI will respond to additional questions from registered interveners, BCUC staff and the Panel during a question and answer period;
5. In order to respond to any confidential questions posed, arrangements will be made for an in-camera session if required; and
6. The Panel Chair will ask FEI to provide a final submission verbally. Registered interveners will be then asked to provide verbal final submissions. FEI will then have the opportunity for a verbal reply submission.
