I've noticed an strange irregularity in the registration of intervenors for the above inquiry. It appears that BCUC has allowed registrations for:

C9-1	CITY OF NORTH VANCOUVER (CoNV) - Letter dated September 9, 2019 Request to Intervene by Ben Themens
C12-1	CITY OF RICHMOND (CoR) - Letter dated September 10, 2019 Request to Intervene by Anthony Capuccinello Iraci
C13-1	LULU ISLAND ENERGY COMPANY LTD. (LIEC) - Letter dated September 10, 2019 Request to Intervene by Anthony Capuccinello Iraci

It appears that both the City of North Vancouver and the City of Richmond have been able to acquire duplicate intervenor status.

This matter should be resolved by combining them into two intervenors representing the City of North Vancouver and the City of Richmond. The reason is from a weighting of evidence and cost point of view and deleting C9-1 and C13-1.

Mr. Ben Themens primary job title is Director of Finance City of North Vancouver.

Mr. Anthony Capuccinello Iraci is the Solicitor for the City of Richmond.

As this is a defining issue being discussed, the BCUC should maintain a level playing field for submissions. The lack of public involvement is already a concern.
