By Order G-177-19 dated August 1, 2019, the British Columbia Utilities Commission (BCUC) established an inquiry to examine the regulation of energy utilities affiliated with municipalities and regional districts in British Columbia (Inquiry).

By letter dated October 7, 2019, Don Flintoff, a registered intervener in the Inquiry, requested clarification on the intervener status of Lonsdale Energy Corp. (LEC) and Lulu Island Energy Company Ltd. (LIEC). Don Flintoff is concerned that LEC and LIEC have duplicated their representation and intervener status, as their interests are substantially similar with that of the City of North Vancouver and the City of Richmond, respectively. The City of North Vancouver and the City of Richmond are also registered interveners in the Inquiry.

The BCUC requests that LEC and LIEC respond to this request and in your response address the following:

1. Whether your respective municipality’s interests are substantially similar to your own such that you should coordinate as one intervener as outlined in section 10.03 of the BCUC’s Rules of Practice and Procedure.
