These are BCSEA's submissions on further process, pursuant to Order G-316-19.¹

1. BCSEA does not intend to provide intervener evidence in this proceeding.
2. BCSEA has no objection to the Proposed Regulatory Timetable set out in Appendix B to Order G-316-19, which provides for intervener evidence and information requests on the intervener evidence.
3. BCSEA anticipates no periods of unavailability relevant to the regulatory timetable.
