2.38.1 Please provide the most recent version of the Facility Asset Management Plan for the Campbell River System.

RESPONSE:

There is no single Facility Asset Plan for the Campbell River System. The Campbell River System consists of three facilities:

- 1) Ladore Generating Station – For the Ladore Generating Station Facility Asset Plan, please refer to BC Hydro's response to BCUC IR 1.86.6 which includes the Ladore Facility Asset Plan;
- 2) Strathcona Generating Station – For the Strathcona Generating Station Facility Asset Plan, please refer to BC Hydro's response to BCUC IR 1.87.6 which includes the Strathcona Facility Asset Plan; and
- 3) John Hart Generating Station – BC Hydro was granted a CPCN to redevelop the John Hart Generating Station as described in the John Hart Generating Station Replacement Project CPCN Application – Decision and Commission Order No. C-2-13. As a result, there is no current Facility Asset Plan for John Hart Generating Station as it is being redeveloped. Under a public private partnership agreement, the InPower BC General Partnership is responsible for the asset availability, performance and condition for the first 15 years the new assets are in service as described in section 5.4.4.1 of the Application.
