This is an unsolicited response by BCSEA to the March 12, 2020 correspondence from FortisBC Alternative Energy Services Inc. (FAES) to the Commission [Exhibit C2-3].

BCSEA confirms FAES's understanding that BCSEA would like the record in this proceeding to include assembled information regarding Primary and Peaking/Backup energy sources for projects registered with the BCUC under Stream A, and that BCSEA, for its part, does not require access to the approved Stream A applications or for those documents to be put on the record as exhibits in this proceeding. BCSEA acknowledges that the Commission or parties may find value in having the approved Stream applications on the record.

Appendix A of FAES's Exhibit C2-3 provides summary information on the technology and fuel sources for each of FAES's Stream A facilities, in conjunction with FAES's Stream A TES Annual Report for 2019. BCSEA appreciates FAES taking the initiative to provide this information. From BCSEA's perspective, it would be helpful for other participating TES providers to file similar information in a similar format.
