**Re: British Columbia Hydro and Power Authority – F2020–F2021 Revenue Requirements Application – Project No. 1598990 – Final Submissions Extension**

By letter dated June 2, 2020, the British Columbia Utilities Commission (BCUC) indicated interveners could provide their final submissions by Tuesday, June 16, 2020 and that British Columbia Hydro and Power Authority (BC Hydro) would then have the opportunity to provide a written reply to intervenor submissions, if any, by Thursday, June 18, 2020. These final submissions and reply follow the oral phase of argument which took place on Friday, June 12, 2020.

On June 15, 2020, Mr. Chris O’Riley filed a letter with respect to BC Hydro’s compliance with Mandatory Reliability Standards and vegetation management standards and asked that the BCUC post it on the proceeding website and identify the letter as an additional submission. BC Hydro supports an extension of time for interveners to file their reply comments to their submissions relating to this matter.

The Panel has considered this request and considers that an extension to the remaining regulatory timetable is appropriate. Accordingly, interveners may provide a written submission with their positions regarding any issues arising, if applicable, by Thursday, June 18, 2020. BC Hydro has the opportunity to provide a written reply to intervenor submissions, if any, by Monday, June 22, 2020.
