Please state your reasons for intervening in this proceeding:

Suncor Energy is an integrated Canadian energy company. The company supplies refined petroleum products into British Columbia from its Edmonton refinery and operates or supplies 229 Petro-Canada service stations across the province, as well as third-party marketers and commercial fuel customers. Suncor fully participated in the BCUC's Inquiry into Gasoline and Diesel Prices in British Columbia and is currently participating in the BCUC's industry engagement regarding

the data collection process for the wholesale fuel industry. The Fuel Price Transparency Act (FPT Act) and amended FPT Regulations require fuel importers, wholesalers, terminal owners/operators, and those who supply fuel to retail dealers to submit regular reports to the BCUC, as Administrator, starting in November 2020. Suncor and certain affiliates are required to provide information to the BCUC pursuant to the amended FPT Regulations. Accordingly, Parkland's request for an advance confidentiality ruling pertaining to this reporting is of interest to Suncor.
