Husky Energy is a Canadian based integrated energy company. Its Integrated Corridor includes a North American downstream business that includes manufacturing assets in Alberta, Saskatchewan, Ohio, and Wisconsin which produce a range of products including gasoline, jet fuel, diesel, asphalt, and petrochemical feedstocks. Husky Energy also operates retail gasoline outlets and a commercial fuels network in Canada, including British Columbia. Husky Energy

participated in the BCUC's industry engagement regarding the data collection process for the wholesale fuel industry.
