Response to SFU’s Request for Access to Confidential Documents**

On November 27, 2020, a letter was submitted to the British Columbia Utilities Commission (“**BCUC**”) on behalf of Simon Fraser University (“**SFU**”) requesting access to the confidential documents filed by Corix Multi-Utility Services Inc. (“**Corix**”) in this proceeding.

SFU’s Burnaby Mountain University Campus is a utility customer of Corix’s Burnaby Mountain District Energy Utility (“**BMDEU**”), receiving thermal energy service from Corix pursuant to a negotiated Thermal Energy Services Agreement between SFU and Corix (“**Agreement**”). This Agreement, which outlines terms and conditions of service specific to SFU only, was approved by the BCUC through Order C-5-17, dated September 15, 2017. Due to the nature of this Agreement between SFU and Corix, Corix does not object to the BCUC providing SFU access to all pertinent confidential documents in this proceeding, regarding approvals related to SFU.
