**Re:** **British Columbia Utilities Commission – Inquiry into the Regulation of Safety – Submissions on the Insurance Corporation of British Columbia**

On September 23, 2020, by Order G-241-20, the British Columbia Utilities Commission (BCUC) established an inquiry to examine the role of the BCUC in the regulation of safety (Inquiry). The regulatory timetable included intervener registration and written submissions on the BCUC's jurisdiction with respect to the regulation of safety, legislative gaps or overlaps and whether a workshop in support of the Inquiry would be beneficial.

On November 12, 2020, MoveUP filed a submission stating, in part, that certain sections of the *Utilities Commission Act* (UCA) apply to the Insurance Corporation of British Columbia (ICBC) and that ICBC is not statutorily excluded from the scope of Inquiry. MoveUP recommended that the BCUC include consideration of safety issues at ICBC in the Inquiry.<sup>1</sup>

On November 17, 2020, ICBC filed a letter of comment addressing MoveUp's submission.<sup>2</sup> ICBC stated that the sections of the UCA that reference safety have been made inapplicable to ICBC by virtue of section 44 of the *Insurance Corporation Act*. ICBC requested that the BCUC confirm that its jurisdiction for safety does not include ICBC.<sup>3</sup>

The BCUC requests submissions from stakeholders and participants on the following, by **Wednesday, January 6, 2021**:

- Should the scope of the Inquiry include the regulation of safety for ICBC?

ICBC may provide a written reply to submissions received by **Wednesday, January 13, 2021**.
