**Re: Corix Multi-Utility Services Inc.  
Burnaby Mountain District Energy Utility 2020-2023 Revenue Requirement and Rates Application  
Request for Extension to Evidentiary Update Deadline**

---

On July 30, 2020, Corix Multi-Utility Services Inc. (“**Corix**”) submitted an application seeking British Columbia Utilities Commission (“**BCUC**”) approval of its Burnaby Mountain District Energy Utility (“**BMDEU**”) revenue requirements and rates from 2020 through to 2023, effective September 1, 2020 (“**Application**”). September 1, 2020 represented the anticipated service commencement date for the new central energy plant (“**CEP**”) at BMDEU.

By Order G-220-20, dated August 19, 2020, the BCUC established a regulatory timetable for the review of the Application. The regulatory timetable included Corix’s submission of an Evidentiary Update on February 4, 2021 with further process to be determined. The Application filing date provided time for new customer rates to be established with an effective date that aligned with the anticipated service commencement date (September 1, 2020). As the rates proposed in the Application included calculations based on projected capital costs for the new CEP, the Evidentiary Update was anticipated to contain capital costs based on the final project invoices for the new CEP. The Evidentiary Update would also contain any necessary updates to the forecast costs, revenue requirements and proposed final rates.

The actual service commencement date for the new CEP was October 23, 2020. With the delays associated with the new CEP, Corix will not receive the final capital project cost invoices in time to prepare the Evidentiary Update for February 4, 2021.

Corix respectfully requests an extension of the deadline to file the Evidentiary Update from February 4, 2021 to March 18, 2021. This extension is consistent with the delay to the service commencement date and will allow Corix to update the Application in a manner that more accurately reflects the actual capital costs associated with the construction of the new CEP. Corix will propose an outline for the remainder of the regulatory review process at the time of filing of the Evidentiary Update.
