**ORDER**

**WHEREAS:**

- A. On July 30, 2020, Corix Multi-Utility Services Inc. (Corix) submitted an application seeking British Columbia Utilities Commission (BCUC) approval of its Burnaby Mountain District Energy Utility (BMDEU) revenue requirements and rates from 2020 through to 2023, effective September 1, 2020 (Application);
- B. By Order G-220-20 dated August 19, 2020, the BCUC established a regulatory timetable consisting of a virtual workshop, one round of BCUC and intervener information requests (IRs), Corix submission of an evidentiary update, and further process to be determined. The regulatory timetable was subsequently amended by Order G-331-20 dated December 15, 2020 and Order G-348-20 dated December 23, 2020;
- C. On January 15, 2021, Corix requested an extension of the deadline to file the evidentiary update from February 4, 2021 to March 18, 2021 (Extension Request). Corix states the requested extension is consistent with the delay to the service commencement date of the central energy plant (CEP) and will allow Corix to update the Application in a manner that more accurately reflects the actual capital costs associated with the construction of the new CEP;
- D. In the Extension Request, Corix also states that it will propose an outline for the remainder of the regulatory review process at the time of filing of the evidentiary update; and
- E. The BCUC has reviewed Corix's extension request and determines that an amendment to the regulatory timetable is warranted.

**NOW THEREFORE** the BCUC orders the regulatory timetable is amended, as set out in Appendix A to this order.
