I wish to say NO to this planned expansion. The Fraser River is no place to situate a facility such as this and is most definitely NOT a place to consider an LNG taker shipping facility. Under international rules for shipment of hazardous materials this must NOT be allowed to proceed. In addition, the Fraser River is a lifeline for our salmon and other fish. It is on the brink of failure to sustain as of now. a large tanker shipping facility will probably be the last straw for salmon and endangered sturgeon on the Fraser River. This in addition to the fact that we must wean ourselves off fossil fuels if we have any hope of saving our environment. a massive cloud of Methane (the most polluting of gases) has been photographed from space over Northern Alberta and BC. LNG is touting itself as a clean fuel, but this is erroneous when you consider that the majority of LNG is now fracked gas.
